

## Care of Partial Denture

Remove the partial at night and sleep without it. Clean the partial and your teeth with a brush every time you eat, whenever possible. When not possible, remove it; rinse your mouth and the partial with water to remove all food particles trapped underneath. This helps prevent decay of the teeth supporting the partial. Brush and floss at the first opportunity.

Use an approved partial denture cleaner once every 1-3 weeks.

Approved cleaners for partial dentures:

- 1. Polident Cleaner**
- 2. Kleenite**
- 3. Stain-Away**
- 4. Fixodent**
- 5. Efferdent**

(For titanium partial: 1, 2 & 3 only.)

All are available at most local pharmacies.

Avoid wrapping your partial in a napkin if removed when away from home. These are too easily thrown away inadvertently.

Do not allow your dog access to your partial, for instance: when laid on your night stand. They love the smell and chew them up.

For Caregiver: Remove partial denture using clasps carefully. Pull down on the right then the left, removing it at a tilt. Brush real teeth and the partial. Leave the partial out at night and replace it each morning. Brush after meals. Have patient rinse every night with Fluorgard rinse for 1 minute, and then spit out. Do not rinse.
