

## **Temporary Crown Information**

1. Avoid **HARD** or **STICKY** foods and chewing gum.
2. Floss daily.
3. Floss in ONE-DIRECTION ONLY: TOWARD the gum tissue.  
Remove floss by pulling it out to the side with one hand only (don't pop it back out).
4. Brush gum tissue gently on both sides of temporary crown.

Call office immediately if the temporary crown comes off or loosens. Important: Bring temporary to the office with you.

If necessary, use Vaseline or denture adhesive gel (the BEST!) to hold temporary crown in place until you can have it recemented. Remove loose crown while sleeping.
